**Please use this daily prayer calendar for the creation of life-transforming Christian literature around the world through LittWorld 2012, October 28 to November 2, in Kenya.**

- 1** Pray for God's guidance and wisdom for conference speakers. Pray that every session will contribute to the heightened effectiveness of each Christian publisher and writer attending the conference, and that Christ will be exalted.
- 2** Pray for God's blessing upon the nation of Kenya, our host venue for LittWorld. Pray for the nation's presidential elections next year and for election of a godly candidate.
- 3** Please pray that many publishing staff from the Middle East, China and other challenging locations for Christian publishing will be able to attend LittWorld 2012. Pray for God's protection and wisdom for them as they publish good news in highly sensitive and sometimes violent contexts.
- 4** LittWorld plenary sessions will be interpreted into French for participants from Francophone Africa. Please pray for a highly proficient team of French interpreters/translators at the conference and for God's strength as they carry out their demanding task.
- 5** Thank God for Host Chair Barine Kirimi and other volunteer members of the Africa Organizing Team. LittWorld 2012 could not happen without their devoted and sacrificial dedication to the many tasks of hosting an international conference.
- 6** Please pray that God will begin preparing the hearts and minds of LittWorld 2012 participants so that everyone arrives ready to learn, grow, share and encourage one another.
- 7** Pray that participants, through the Holy Spirit, experience a sense of unity in purpose and vision.
- 8** Many people in Christian publishing work in isolated settings, in countries where the local Church is small. Pray that LittWorld sparks the creation of lasting friendships that span borders and continents.
- 9** Many cultures, languages and nations will be represented at LittWorld 2012. Pray the love of Christ will overcome any potential cross-cultural misunderstandings, and that participants will experience 1 Corinthians 13 in action.
- 10** International Christian publishing is undergoing extreme change, and LittWorld participants will come looking for help with digital publishing, social media and other new technologies. Pray that workshops and sessions on the new technologies will give practical helps and clarity in these areas.
- 11** Many men and women in Christian publishing are weary from working in under-staffed conditions. Pray that the Holy Spirit would refresh them and renew their vision.
- 12** Attending an international conference like LittWorld may feel unattainable for many people. Pray that God would draw all those whom He desires to be present and open doors for them to come.
- 13** Pray for special encouragement, networking and friendship among the 20 invited men and women who attend the Francophone Africa pre-conference week-end.
- 14** LittWorld provides an opportunity to think outside day-to-day tasks. Pray that this unique gathering would spark ideas for needed books, articles, magazines and graphics/illustrations.
- 15** Technology makes our lives so much easier, but when it fails, we hit major roadblocks. Please pray for working technology at each workshop, plenary session and elsewhere.
- 16** Cottages, workshop rooms, the dining hall and other buildings are spread out across the lush, gardenlike grounds of the conference center. Since participants must walk between locations, please pray for good weather.
- 17** After intense learning and networking during the conference, pray that the mid-week afternoon outing would provide needed refreshment and opportunities to build friendships.
- 18** Travel, climate changes, new foods and the stressors of daily life can take tolls on health. Please pray for good health for everyone involved in the conference.
- 19** Thank God for the staff of Brackenhurst Conference Center who will provide hospitality to nearly 150 men and women. Pray for their wisdom and strength.
- 20** Please pray that the writing competition enables the exchange of global voices and uncovers new writing talent.
- 21** Please pray that the cross-fertilization of the world's best ideas would improve or spur new publishing methods or products.
- 22** Pray that MAI will identify at least five potential trainers among the 150 conference participants, and that they will help us equip publishers and writers in their own countries.
- 23** Thank God for the many groups and individuals who provided LittWorld scholarship gifts, enabling the participation of more than 30 people who would not otherwise have been able to attend.
- 24** Pray for Dr. Florence Muindi of Kenya as she prepares to give the Oct. 28 opening-night message. Pray that her talk inspires attendees and sets the right spiritual tone for the start of LittWorld.
