Article: Perfect 7 on 1
[7 PARAGRAPHS ON ONE SUBJECT]


1. Facts about one concrete subject

Write 3-5 short sentences of facts about one concrete subject – motor rickshaw, banana, hot weather, people who sleep in church, elephant, snake, statue of Buddha, etc. Use action verbs and 5 senses.




2. Write more about Last Fact mentioned in #1

Write more details about the last fact you presented in paragraph # 1 above. Use action verbs, 5 senses. 3-5 sentences.




3. How ancient civilization might see (or saw) your concrete subject.

Imagine how ancient peoples of your country – Cambodia – would respond if they saw your concrete subject. Or, how did they respond to it (if you know). Write a short scene of 3-5 sentences. (Or you might choose how people in Bible times saw your subject.)




4. Personal story of experience with subject told by other person or animal.

Story shows how your character responded to the subject. What happened? What did the person think about the subject or how were they changed by it? 3-5 sentences.




5. Your own personal story with the subject

Tell your own experience in story form about what happened between you and the subject from paragraph #1. What happened? End your story with one question you have about the subject. 3-5 sentences



6. More facts about the subject

Share facts as you did in paragraph #1, but add more, new facts. Some of these new facts could come from the personal stories.



7. Conclusion

Close with 2-3 sentences in which you share your personal feelings about the subject. Show strong emotion.
